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## Key Terms

<b>MPS Traditional Schools</b>	MPS traditional schools serve students preK - Grade 12 in a variety of elementary, middle, high and bi-level school configurations. These schools are staffed by MPS employees.
<b>Alternative Schools</b>	MPS schools that provide specialized services to students who are identified as being at risk of dropping out or who are experiencing difficulties in or are transitioning back to the traditional school setting.
<b>MPS Programs</b>	MPS has contracts with community agencies to provide specialized services to students with special needs and who are identified as being at risk of dropping out or who are experiencing difficulties in the traditional school setting.
<b>Special Education Contracted Schools</b>	MPS has contracts with community agencies to provide specialized services to students with special education needs that cannot be served in a traditional school setting.
<b>Partnership School</b>	MPS has contracts with community agencies to provide alternative school options for students who are identified as being at risk of dropping out or who are experiencing difficulty in the traditional school setting.
<b>Non-Instrumentality Charter Schools</b>	Non-instrumentality charter schools are public, nonsectarian schools created through a businesslike contract or "charter" between the charter school and MPS. These schools do not employ MPS staff and operate their own facility or lease from MPS.
<b>MPS Sites</b>	MPS sites refer the different types of schools listed above: traditional, alternative, MPS programs, special education contracted, partnership, and non-instrumentality.
<b>Chapter 220</b>	Chapter 220, the Voluntary Student Transfer Program, aims to racially integrate schools. Minority students including African Americans, Asians, Hispanics, and Native Americans may attend any of 22 suburban school districts depending upon where they live in Milwaukee and whether seats are available in the suburban district they wish to attend. Transportation is provided.
<b>Open Enrollment</b>	Open Enrollment is a state-wide program that allows students to attend public schools in districts other than their own if seats are available. No transportation is provided unless the child has an Individualized Education Program (IEP) that specifies that transportation must be provided.
<b>Enrollment by School Type</b>	Enrollment summary identifies student enrollment by school type and includes MPS sites and Chapter 220 and Open Enrollment students.
<b>Enrollment by Grade Level</b>	Grade level summary identifies student enrollment by grade level at MPS sites and does not include Chapter 220 or Open Enrollment.
